Our world has 1 billion people living with a disability, and more older adults (65 years+) than children under the age of 5.

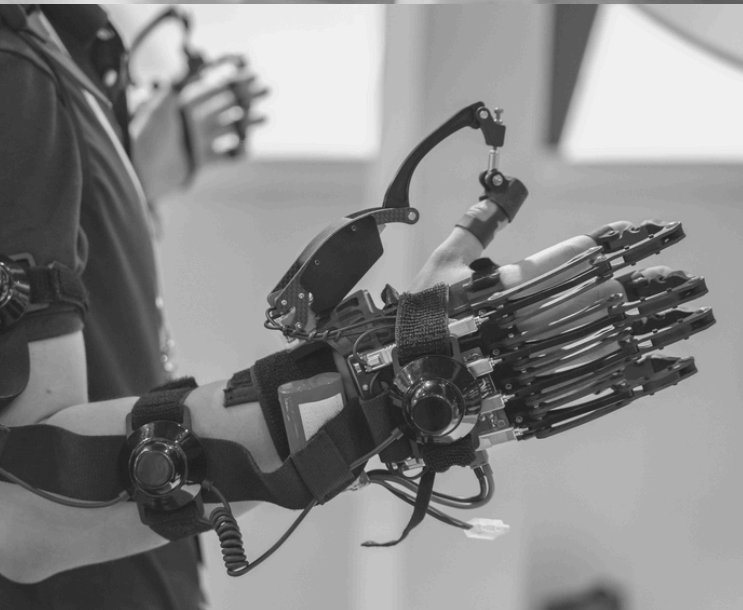
